CLASS PRICES

- \$13 30-minute class
- \$15 45-minute class
- \$17 1-hour class
- \$70 Junior Capped fee (you can do as many classes as you want and pay no more than the capped fee)
- \$80 Senior Capped fee
- \$35 30-minute Private Lesson (not included in capped fee)

Ballet Exam Class, Tap & Jazz Exam combined Classes: 30-minute \$15, 45-minute class \$18, 1 hour \$20 If you choose to only do one genre in the combined tap & jazz exam class, **\$15.00** -20 min or **\$17.00** -30 min.

Ballet Exam 2nd class will be charged at the normal class price (not included in capped fee)

Casual classes available ONLY for Adult & Open classes 45 mins @ \$22 There are NO registration fees charged.

Fees & Procedures: (We accept Active Kids & Creative Kids Vouchers towards Enrolment and Fees)

A non-refundable fee of \$50 is payable upon enrolment. (TROUPE PERFORMANCE STUDENTS a \$50 upfront fee is also payable upon enrolment for eisteddfod competition Fee's) this is not including ADS or Moondance Comps. Fees are payable only by the term, Fees must be paid even when absent, this includes being away on family holidays or any other reason your child is absent, special consideration is given ONLY under certain circumstances and confirmed by Miss Cherie. An invoice will be emailed out and can be paid directly, or cash & Eftpos is accepted at the studio. Please ensure your details are always up-to-date, please advise the front desk or email any changes to your enrolment, classes and contact details.

(A late fee of \$25 will apply to term fees if not paid by the first week of term)

Refunds:

Refunds will not be given due to illness (including COVID-19) injury or change of mind, exceptions to this will be decided on a case-by-case basis by the principal. There are NO REFUNDS for classes not attended. Paid fees cannot be transferred to another student or family member.

Notices / Information:

It is the parent's responsibility to check your emails & Facebook as this is how we will communicate and send messages. No parent is to stay with a student whilst a class is being conducted. Special watching days will be held during the year where parents and relatives can watch their young dancers in class.

Injury / Medical Conditions:

It is the parents or student's responsibility to notify their teacher in the event of injury/medical condition during or prior to class. The first aid box is available to any student through their teacher if needed.

Safety:

KC Dance Co is committed to providing a safe and healthy place for teachers, dancers and visitors.

Whilst all care is taken, and all classes are fully supervised KC DANCE COMPANY accepts no responsibility for damage, loss or injury on the premises.

Dancers should be picked up on time by a parent or guardian at the end of their class/es.

When students leave the premises, they are no longer in our care.

Concert:

It is not compulsory for a student to be involved in the annual performances; however, it is preferred. Costume prices will be kept at a minimum.

It is compulsory to attend the dress rehearsal/s & stage rehearsals for the end of year performance.

Class Attire:

All students must be appropriately dressed for class, we have a uniform but it is not compulsory, as long as your child is in some sort of leotard or dance attire, with the correct footwear, with their hair tied back securely, that will be excepted. No excess jewellery is to be worn.

Dress Code for Ballet, Tap & Jazz Exam Classes:

A dress code for ballet, tap and jazz exam classes ensures that the teacher can correct the dances alignment and positioning. For ballet classes a leotard and stockings must be worn and hair in a bun, in the hotter weather small ankle socks are acceptable in place of stockings. In Tap & Jazz classes a leotard and KC shorts are required. Baggy clothing is not acceptable attire for these technique classes. Please talk to your teacher if you have any concerns with this rule. If your child is not correctly dressed, they will not be allowed to attend class.
